3	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to		
4	retroactively accept and expend funds from the California Department of Food and		
5	Agriculture (CDFA) in the amount of \$191,664.48 in support of the Pierce's Disease		
6	Control Program, for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010.

8	WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from CDFA for the Pierce's Disease Control		
9	Program (PDCP) for the three fiscal year period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010 for a		
10	total amount of \$191,664.48; and,		
11	WHEREAS, The purpose of the PDCP is to minimize the statewide impact of Pierce's		
12	disease and its vectors in California; and,		
13	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDFA requires the City to		
14	enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the		
15	Board of Supervisors in File No. 071392; which is hereby declared to be a part of this		
16	resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
17	WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of		
18	\$33,122.67 (annual amount of \$11,040.89); and,		
19	WHEREAS, DPH received the contract from CDFA on August 1, 2007 with a start date		
20	of July 1, 2007, hence the retroactive request; and,		
21	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses the		
22	department for four existing positions, including two Agricultural Biologists (Job Class #3540)		
23	at .28 FTE; one Agricultural Commissioner (Job Class #0922) at .04 FTE, and one Jr.		
24	Administrative Analyst (Job Class #1820) at .02 FTE; now, therefore, be it
