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3	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency to accept		
4	and expend \$200,000 of Regional Measure 2 - Safe Routes to Transit funding to		
5	conduct a study analyzing how to improve traffic patterns on the southern side of the		
6	Balboa Park BART station.		
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8	WHEREAS, On March 2, 2004, voters in seven Bay Area counties cumulatively passed		
9	Regional Measure 2, which imposed a \$1.00 toll on the nine State-owned toll bridges in the		
10	San Francisco Bay Area effective July 1, 2004; and,		
11	WHEREAS, Regional Measure 2 will raise an estimated \$125 million each year to		
12	implement the Regional Traffic Relief Plan, which includes transit operating assistance and		
13	funding of specified capital projects within the region that have been determined to reduce		
14	congestion or make improvements to travel in the toll bridge corridors; and		
15	WHEREAS, Regional Measure 2 allocates \$20 million for Safe Routes to Transit		
16	projects that involve the planning and construction of bicycle and pedestrian access		
17	improvements in close proximity to transit facilities; and		
18	WHEREAS, As the transportation planning, coordinating and financing agency of the		
19	nine-county Bay Area, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) allocates Regional		
20	Measure 2 funding; and,		
21	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency of the City and		
22	County of San Francisco (SFMTA) is an eligible sponsor of transportation project(s) using		
23	Regional Measure 2, Regional Traffic Relief Plan funds; and

1	WHEREAS, The SFMTA has applied to MTC for \$200,000 in Safe Routes to Transit
2	funding to conduct a study analyzing how to improve traffic patterns on the southern side of
3	the Balboa Park BART station; and
4	WHEREAS, The SFMTA's Safe Routes to Transit project is eligible for consideration in
5	the Regional Traffic Relief Plan of Regional Measure 2, as identified in California Streets and
6	Highways Code Section 30914(c) or (d); and
7	WHEREAS, On October 16, 2007, the SFMTA Board of Directors adopted Resolution
8	07-164, which authorized the SFMTA to accept and expend \$200,000 in Safe Routes to
9	Transit funding to conduct a study analyzing how to improve traffic patterns on the southern
10	side of the Balboa Park BART station; and
11	WHEREAS, There is no allowance for citywide indirect costs; and
12	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; now,
13	therefore be it
14	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco Municipal
15	Transportation Agency to accept and expend \$200,000 of available Safe Routes to Transit
16	funds to conduct a study analyzing how to improve traffic patterns on the southern side of the
17	Balboa Park BART station; and, be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of citywide
19	indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SFMTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional
21	information as may be requested by the funding agency in connection with this request; and,
