7	WHEREAS, On November 7, 2006, California voters approved Proposition 1B, the
8	Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Bond Act of 2006; and,
9	WHEREAS, Under the Proposition, the State will appropriate two billion dollars into the
10	Locals Streets and Roads Account; and,
11	WHEREAS, The FY 2007-08 Budget Bill (SB 78) included a \$600 million appropriation
12	for cities and counties from the Local Streets and Roads Account; and,
13	WHEREAS, SB 88, the budget trailer bill, which provides for the implementation of
14	Proposition 1B, included an additional appropriation of \$350 million for this purpose, for a total
15	of \$950 million for cities and counties in FY 2007-08; and,
16	WHEREAS, AB 196 specifies that the \$950 million is to be appropriated \$400 million
17	for counties and \$550 million for cities; and,
18	WHEREAS, Each city and county must submit to the State Department of Finance a
19	list of projects expected to be funded with bond funds before an allocation is made; and,
20	WHEREAS, Project lists submitted to the State Department of Finance are flexible and
21	substitutions are allowed to respond to local priorities; and,
2223	WHEREAS, Bond funds have a three-year "use it or lose it" provision that specifically
24	requires the funds to be expended within three fiscal years after the fiscal year in which the

1	State Controller makes the allocation. This means that all Proposition 1B Local Streets and		
2	Roads monies appropriated in FY 2007-08 must be expended by June 30, 2011; and,		
3	WHEREAS, All of San Francisco's shares of the Proposition 1B Local Streets and		
4	Roads bond funds are programmed to the Department of Public Works' street resurfacing		
5	program in the FY 2007-08 Citywide Capital Plan, approved by the Board of Supervisors		
6	under Resolution No. 145-07 on March 27, 2007; and,		
7	WHEREAS, San Francisco's city share of Proposition 1B Local Streets and Roads		
8	monies is \$13,043,484, of which \$5,589,668 was appropriated to the Department of Public		
9	Works in the City and County of San Francisco's FY 2007-08 annual budget, Ordinance No.		
10	174-07, and \$7,453,816 is proposed to be appropriated to the Department of Public Works		
11	under Ordinance No. ; and,		
12	WHEREAS, San Francisco's county share of Proposition 1B Local Streets and Roads		
13	monies is \$5,833,622, of which \$4,396,810 was appropriated to the Department of Public
