8	WHEREAS, Resolution No. 193-04 transferred ownership of the Geneva Office
9	Building and Powerhouse (the "Building") from the San Francisco Municipal Transportation
10	Authority to the Recreation and Parks Department (the "Department'); and,
11	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors effectuated this transfer to preserve the Geneva
12	Office Building and for the adaptive re-use of the Building as a new space for youth and teen
13	arts; and,
14	WHEREAS, Since 2003, the Friends of the Geneva Office Building (the "Friends") has
15	worked to preserve, rehabilitate and re-use the Building; and,
16	WHEREAS, Friends has educated City and State leaders on the importance of the
17	Building, its potential as a neighborhood resource and has successfully advocated for City
18	and State funds for the Building; and,
19	WHEREAS, In 2004, the Friends commissioned the Carrie & Co Architectural firm to
20	develop a conceptual plan to redevelop the Building; and,
21	WHEREAS, In 2006, the Friends applied for and received \$200,000 from the California
22	Cultural and Historic Endowment (CCHE) to partially fund the design phase of the restoration
23	of the Building; and,
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1	WHEREAS, In FY 2006-2007, the City allocated \$1.2 million towards the design phase
2	of the restoration of the Building and the Department is now working to complete the required
3	design work; now, therefore, be it
4	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
5	urges the Recreation and Parks Commission to enter into a grant agreement with the Friends
6	of the Geneva Office Building for the planning of, design for and the completion of the
7	rehabilitation of the Building as well as the eventual programming use of the Geneva Office
8	Building.
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
