RESOLUTION NO.

1	[Urging the United States Senate to immediately ratify Annex VI of the International
2	Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships Urging the Port of San Francisco to prohibit any vessels that uses heavy bunker oil from docking on Port property.]

4	Resolution urging the Port of San Francisco to prohibit any vessels that uses heavy
5	bunker oil from docking on Port property urging the United States Senate to
6	immediately ratify Annex VI of the International Convention for the Prevention of
7	Pollution from Ships.

9	WHEREAS, On November 7, 2007, the cargo vessel Cosco Busan collided with the
10	Bay Bridge, leaking 58,000 gallons of heavy bunker oil into the San Francisco Bay; and,
11	WHEREAS, Because of the high concentrations of sulfur, 2.5 percent and carcinogenic
12	polycyclic aromatics, 13-18 percent, heavy bunker oil is considered to be the most damaging
13	to the environment of all the marine fuels; and,
14	WHEREAS, These concentrations are compared with sulfur fuels such as marine
15	diesel oil and marine gas oil which each have a sulfur content of approximately one half
16	percent; and,
17	WHEREAS, High concentrations of sulfur and polycyclic aromatics in heavy bunker oil
18	contribute to acid rain and other environmental cataestrophes; and,
19	WHEREAS, High concentrations of carcinogenic polycyclic aromatics and sulfur also
20	make spills of heavy bunker oil, particularly damaging to the marine environment as well as
21	clean up crews; and,
22	WHEREAS, Because of its comparatively low price, heavy bunker oil is used by a large
23	percentage of the world's cargo vessels, including those that dock in the Ports of the San
24	Francisco Bay; and,

1	WHEREAS, Annex VI of the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution
2	from Ships (MARPOL Annex VI) would allow the United States to prohibit the use of bunker of
3	within 200 miles of the west coast; and,
4	WHEREAS, The United States Senate has not yet ratified MARPOL Annex VI, now,
5	therefore, be it
6	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
7	urges the Port of San Francisco to prohibit any vessels that use high sulfur heavy bunker oil
8	from docking on any Port Properties; and, be it
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board urges all Ports located within the San
10	Francisco to jointly prohibit the use of heavy bunker oil by ships which dock in the San
11	Francisco Bay; and be it
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board
13	to send a copy of this resolution to the directors of the San Francisco, Oakland, Richmond
14	and Redwood City Ports.
15	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Senate of the United States of
16	America to immediately ratify Annex VI to the International Convention for the Prevention of
17	Pollution from Ships (MARPOL Annex VI); and, be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board urges the Environmental Protection Agency to
19	upon ratification of MARPOL Annex VI, immediately prohibit the use of bunker oil within 200
20	miles of the west coast of the United States; and, be it
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board
22	to send a copy of this resolution to Senator Boxer, Senator Feinstein and the Administrator of
23	the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
