7	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) collects
8	more than \$200 million in annual revenue from transit fares, citation payments and sales of
9	various fare media and has more than 15 facilities throughout the city, including transit
10	stations, vehicle storage yards and service centers; and,
11	WHEREAS, These facilities require the services of armed and unarmed security
12	guards to act as a first deterrent for inappropriate activities and for the safety of SFMTA
13	personnel, to protect SFMTA property and the public, and to guard against vandalism; and,
14	WHEREAS, The current contract will expire on December 31, 2007; and,
15	WHEREAS, An Invitation for Bids (IFB) was released in September 2007 that resulted
16	in six bids submitted by potential contractors and,
17	WHEREAS, After evaluation of the bids submitted to determine whether they meet
18	minimum qualifications and the 5 percent Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting
19	goal, King Security Services, Inc. was identified as the lowest responsive and responsible
20	bidder; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco Municipal
22	Transportation Agency to execute the Agreement For Armed And Unarmed Security Guard
23	Services with King Security Services Inc. for a term of three years, with option to renew for up
24	to an additional two years, for an amount not to exceed \$17,100,000 million in substantially
