[Agreement with King Security Services Inc. for Armed and Unarmed Security Guard Services]

## Resolution authorizing a three year agreement, with option to renew for up to an additional two years, with King Security Services, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$17,100,000.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) collects more than $\$ 200$ million in annual revenue from transit fares, citation payments and sales of various fare media and has more than 15 facilities throughout the city, including transit stations, vehicle storage yards and service centers; and,

WHEREAS, These facilities require the services of armed and unarmed security guards to act as a first deterrent for inappropriate activities and for the safety of SFMTA personnel, to protect SFMTA property and the public, and to guard against vandalism; and,

WHEREAS, The current contract will expire on December 31, 2007; and,
WHEREAS, An Invitation for Bids (IFB) was released in September 2007 that resulted in six bids submitted by potential contractors and,

WHEREAS, After evaluation of the bids submitted to determine whether they meet minimum qualifications and the 5 percent Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subcontracting goal, King Security Services, Inc. was identified as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency to execute the Agreement For Armed And Unarmed Security Guard Services with King Security Services Inc. for a term of three years, with option to renew for up to an additional two years, for an amount not to exceed $\$ 17,100,000$ million in substantially the form on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. $\qquad$ .
