12	each month shall include an item for the Mayor to appear in person before the Board of Supervisors
13	and engage in formal policy discussions with members of the Board. When the item is read, the Clerk of
14	the Board shall recite the following: "The following is a time dedicated for the Mayor to discuss with
15	the Board of Supervisors issues pertaining to the governance of the City and County of San Francisco.
16	The Board of Supervisors offers this time for dialogue on the third regularly scheduled meeting of ever
17	month at a regularly scheduled Board meeting pursuant to the will of the voters as expressed in
18	Proposition I in November of 2006."
19	Should the mayor fail to appear after five minutes of the item being called, the Clerk shall
20	remove the item from the Board's agenda, and the item shall not be considered by the Board. Should
21	the Mayor appear and the Board therefore consider this item, public comment for this item will take
22	place during general public comment.
