3	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency to accept
4	and expend \$200,000 from Regional Transportation Improvement Program funds
5	allocated by the California Transportation Commission for the Addison and Digby
6	Traffic Circle Project.
7	
8	WHEREAS, The Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) is one element
9	comprising the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), which is a multi-year
10	capital improvement program of transportation projects, funded with revenues from the State
11	Highway Account and other funding sources; and,
12	WHEREAS, Passage of the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port
13	Security Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 1B) by California voters in November 2006 provided
14	funding for a 2006 RTIP Augmentation; and
15	WHEREAS, The 2006 RTIP Augmentation offered the opportunity to amend existing
16	projects programmed in the RTIP; and
17	WHEREAS, As the Regional Transportation Planning Agency for the Bay Area, the
18	Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is responsible for developing regional project
19	priorities for the RTIP for the Bay Area; and,
20	WHEREAS, As the Congestion Management Agency for San Francisco, the San
21	Francisco County Transportation Authority (SFCTA) works with MTC to establish San
22	Francisco project priorities for programming in the RTIP; and
23	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) worked
24	with MTC and SFCTA to allocate a total of \$200,000 in RTIP funding beginning FY2007-08 for
25	the Addison and Digby Traffic Circle Project; and

1	WHEREAS, On October 16, 2007, the SFMTA Board of Directors adopted Resolution
2	No. 07-163, which authorized the SFMTA to accept and expend the RTIP funds for the
3	Addison and Digby Traffic Circle Project and recommended that the Board of Supervisors
4	similarly approve the acceptance and expenditure of the RTIP funds for the Project; and
5	WHEREAS, There is no allowance for citywide indirect costs; and
6	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; now
7	therefore be it
8	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco Municipal
9	Transportation Agency to accept and expend \$200,000 from Regional Transportation
10	Improvement Program funds allocated by the California Transportation Commission for the
11	Addison and Digby Traffic Circle project; and, be it
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives inclusion of citywide
13	indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SFMTA is authorized to furnish whatever additional
15	information as may be requested by the funding agency in connection with this request; and,
16	be it
17	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SFMTA is authorized to execute any and all
18	agreements necessary to complete transfer of the funds.
