14	Permit application to the Department of Public Works (DPW) to close a portion of the Jessie
15	and Mint Street public right-of-ways to automobile traffic and to construct Mint Plaza; and,
16	WHEREAS, On September 14, 2006, after a duly noticed public hearing, the Planning
17	Commission approved Resolution No. 17308 finding that Mint Plaza as set forth in the Street
18	Improvement Permit application was, on balance, in conformity with the General Plan, based
	on its consistency with the policies and objectives of the Transportation, Urban Design and Downtown Elements of the General Plan.
19	WHEREAS, On March 7, 2007, after a duly noticed public hearing, the Director of DPW
20	recommended approval of the Major Encroachment Permit application to construct and
21	maintain Mint Plaza consistent with the Street Improvement Permit application on file with
22	DPW and as set forth in DPW Order No.176,785; and,

6	WHEREAS, On April 10, 2007, after a duly noticed public hearing, the Board of
7	Supervisors approved Resolution No. 174-07 approving closing Jessie Street between 5 th and
8	Mint Streets to vehicular traffic and making environmental findings and findings of consistency
	with the City's General Plan and priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1; and,
9	WHEREAS, On April 20, 2007, the Mayor signed Ordinance No. 83-07 approving the
10	issuance of a major encroachment permit and maintenance agreement to Friends of Mint
11	Plaza to permit the construction and maintenance of Mint Plaza; and,
12	WHEREAS, On November 16, 2007 the construction of Mint Plaza was substantially
13	complete and open to the public; and,
14	RESOLVED, That consistent with San Francisco Public Works Code Section 701, the
	San Francisco Board of Supervisors changes the name of an approximately 200-foot-long
15	portion of Jessie Street between 5 th and Mint Streets and a 75-foot-long portion of Mint Street
16	bounded by Jessie Street to the south to Mint Plaza, to reflect its change in use from a
17	vehicular street to a pedestrian plaza; and,
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors request the
19	Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic to erect street signs indicating both new and
	former name of the street, with the new name "Mint Plaza" in large letters, and the old name
20	"Jessie Street" and "Mint Street" in smaller letters above or beneath the new name; and be it
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That both names of the street shall remain posted on street
22	signs for five years, and then the street signs shall be replaced with signs indicating only the
23	new name, "Mint Plaza."
