

1 [Extending the term of service for the Power Plant Task Force.]

3 **Resolution to extend the expiration date of the Power Plant Task Force from June 1,**  
4 **2007 to December 31, 2009.**

6 WHEREAS, By Resolution 362-99, the Board of Supervisors created a Potrero Power  
7 Plant Citizens Advisory Task Force to advise the City and County of San Francisco regarding  
8 the sale, operation and maintenance of the Potrero Power Plant; and

9 WHEREAS, The Task Force was formed in response to the concerns of San Francisco  
10 residents that the closure of the Hunters Point Power Plant and sale of the Potrero Power  
11 Plant may result in the Potrero Power Plant operating at a higher capacity, and thereby  
12 emitting higher levels of pollution and noise than earlier suspected; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors authorized the Task Force to provide the City  
14 with input on 1) issues which adversely affect the surrounding Bay View and Hunters Point  
15 neighborhoods such as noise, construction, and harmful emissions, 2) power plant workers'  
16 safety issues, and 3) any other related issues deemed appropriate by the Task Force; and,

17 WHEREAS, By Resolutions 1055-00, 139-01, 366-01, 879-01, 733-02, 119-04, 386-04,  
18 and 416-06 the Board of Supervisors has amended the appointment process, adjusted the  
19 membership of the Task Force, renamed it the "Power Plant Task Force" and extended its life  
20 so that it may advise the Board of Supervisors on power policy issues related to the  
21 construction of new power generating facilities in the Southeast portion of San Francisco,  
22 power demand management and an energy policy for the City; and,

23 WHEREAS, The Task Force continues to perform a valuable service to the City  
24 through its examination of issues of concern to San Francisco residents such as the City's  
25 Energy Resource Plan and the Electric Reliability Project; and,

1           WHEREAS, The Task Force members represent a variety of community viewpoints on  
2 power plant issues and the City's energy policy; now, therefore, be it

3           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors extends the term of the Power Plant Task  
4 Force from June 1, 2007 to December 31, 2009.
