Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to retroactively accept a gift from the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation with a monetary value of \$104,538 to back fill-staff attending training designed to decrease the risk of cardiovascular events (heart attacks and strokes) for the period of January 1, 2008 though December 31, 2010.

WHEREAS, studies have shown that ischemic heart disease is the leading cause of premature death amount both men and women; and

WHEREAS, cerebrovascular disease (stroke) is the second leading cause of premature death among women and the fourth leading cause among men; and

WHEREAS, Kaiser Permanente Northern California Region, Community
Benefit Program, Prevent Heart Attacks and Strokes Everyday (PHASE) Initiative 2007
will provide \$399,837 to the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation for the period
of January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010 fund development of programs within
the San Francisco Safety Net to decrease risk of cardiovascular events (hearts and
strokes); and

WHEREAS, Safety Net care in San Francisco is provided by the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) in cooperation with the San Francisco Community Clinic Consortium (SFCCC); and

2	strengthen programs targeted at the City's most vulnerable populations; and	
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4	WHEREAS, the UCSF Department of Family and Community Medicine will	
5	create pilot trainings to develop interventions to improve clinician prescribing practices

9	one and an additional two clinics in year two; and	
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11	WHEREAS, while DPH clinical staff are attending the training their positions will	
12	be back-filled by other staff or by overtime; and

15	\$104,538 to DPH to cover the cost of back-filling the clinical staff while they attend the
