7	WHEREAS, Due to a projected budget shortfall, Mayor Gavin Newsom has declared a
8	hiring freeze for all non-essential positions; and,
9	WHEREAS, Recreation directors, who are charged with managing and staffing our
10	city's recreation centers, have been designated non-essential employees and, thus, vacant
11	Recreation Director positions are subject to the hiring freeze; and,
12	WHEREAS, Recreation facilities are critical for keeping families in San Francisco, for
13	whom City recreation facilities function as a living room and backyard; and,
14	WHEREAS, Recreation facilities provide critical support to the City's violence
15	prevention efforts by offering after school programming and activities; and
16	WHEREAS, Recreation Directors recognize the needs of their neighborhood and can
17	design and implement programs which fulfill the needs of those communities who use their
18	facilities; and,
19	WHEREAS, Staff shortages and reduced hours in recreation centers and clubhouses
20	result in under use of these valuable resources; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor to declare
22	Recreation Directors as essential employees and to unfreeze hiring efforts for all recreation
23	director positions; and, be it

2	resolution be sent to the General Manager of the Recreation and Parks Department and the
3	Recreation and Parks Commission.
