18	Department of Public Health shall provide administrative support for the Committee assign three two		
19	full-time employees to staff	fthe Shelter Monitoring Committee. The Committee shall, among other	
20	things, receive and document complaints made to the Committee regarding shelters and shall		
21	refer complaints to appropriate committee members for follow-up.
