4	and expend retroactively a new three-year grant from the California Department of

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12	WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a three-year grant in the total amount of \$731,070		
13	(\$243,690 annually) from CDPH for a project related to rapid HIV testing; for the period of		
14	October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2010; and,		
15	WHEREAS, This project includes a contract with UCSF for \$698,070 plus \$83,769		
16	(12% contingency in accordance with DPH policy) for the period of October 1, 2007 through		
17	September 30, 2010; and		
18	WHEREAS, The aim of this project is to annually perform 6,000 rapid HIV antibody		
19	tests in San Francisco General Hospital's Emergency Department and effectively link at least		
20	90 percent of newly identified HIV-infected patients into primary care services; and,		
21	WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the funds will be used to partially		
22	reimburse DPH for one existing position, Health Program Coordinator III, Job Class #2593, at		
23	.08 FTE; and,		
24	WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$4,305 (\$1,435		
25	annually); now, therefore, be it		

1	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant		
2	in the amount of \$731,070 (\$243,690 annually) from CDPH; and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the		
4	grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement, pursuant to San		
5	Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it		
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
7	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when		
8	the agreement expires.
