3	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to accept		
4	and expend retroactively a new grant from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation in the		
5	amount of \$215,928, including a retroactive contract with Public Health Foundation		
6	Enterprises, Inc. (PHFE) in the amount of \$207,198, for the "China MSM: Technical		
7	Assistance" project; for the period of January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.

9	WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant for \$215,928 from the Bill and Melinda Gates		
10	Foundation, for the period of January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008; and,		
11	WHEREAS, This project includes a contract with PHFE for \$184,998 plus \$22,200		
12	(12% contingency in accordance with DPH policy) for the period of January 1, 2008 through		
13	December 31, 2008; and		
14	WHEREAS, The aim of this project is to provide technical assistance for men who have		
15	sex with men (MSM) related surveillance and intervention to the National Center for		
16	AIDS/STD Control and Prevention/Chinese Ministry of Health (NCAIDS/MOH) for the		
17	Foundation-supported program on HIV prevention; and,		
18	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the Bill and Melinda Gates		
19	Foundation requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is		
20	on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 080440; which is hereby declared		
21	to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
22	WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the funds will be used to partially		
23	reimburse DPH for three existing positions, including Senior Physician Specialist (Job Class		
24	#2232) at .05 FTE, Manager I (Job Class #0922) at .05 FTE, Epidemiologist I (Job Class		
25	#2802) at .10 FTE; and,

5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
6	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the		
8	grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement, pursuant to San		
9	Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it		
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
11	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when		
12	the agreement expires.
