3 **Resolution declaring April 18, 2008 “Adventures in Music Day” in San Francisco.**

5 WHEREAS, The people of San Francisco are proud to honor the San Francisco
6 Symphony’s internationally acclaimed Adventures in Music (AIM) program; and

7 WHEREAS, The Adventures in Music program reaches every single first through fifth
8 grade student in the San Francisco Unified School District.

9 WHEREAS, A vital part of the San Francisco Symphony’s commitment to it’s
10 community, the entire AIM program is provided free of any charge to every elementary school
11 in the San Francisco Unified School District and in the 2007-2008 school year will reach more
12 than 22,000 elementary school students.

13 WHEREAS, AIM strives to introduce children to a wide range of music, including
14 classical, jazz, Afro-Cuban, and Chinese folk music, and presents ensembles featuring
15 legendary local musicians.

16 WHEREAS, each elementary student in San Francisco receives four in-school AIM
17 ensemble performances and a trip to a San Francisco Symphony concert in Davies
18 Symphony Hall in addition to professional development sessions for teachers, supplemental
19 classroom resources (e.g., instruments, CDs, books, and videos), and workbook journals for
20 each student.

21 WHEREAS, celebrating 20 years in 2008, AIM is the longest running program of its
22 kind of any American Orchestra; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
24 commends the San Francisco Symphony for its astounding Adventures in Music program;
25 and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby declares April 18, 2008
2 Adventures in Music Day in San Francisco.
