5	invalidated portions of this Chapter and enjoined the City from implementing this program. As a		
6	result, the City implemented of	a race-and gender-neutral program under Chapter 14B of the San	
7	Francisco Administrative Cod	de and suspended Chapter 12D.A. of the San Francisco Administrative	
8	Code so long as, and only to	the extent that, the City is enjoined by the court from enforcing the	
9	provisions of this Chapter. In	n the event the injunction is lifted or stayed, Tthis ordinance shall expire	
20	one year from date of said ac	tion. June 30, 2008. If, however, If, during that year, the Commission,	
21	after conducting public hearings, finds that the purposes identified in Section Chapter 12D.A.3		
22	have not yet been achieved and the program continues to be required under federal law, the		
23	Commission shall certify that finding to this Board no later than 120 days prior to the		
24	expiration date. Thereafter, upon finding a good cause, this Board may extend the ordinance		
25	for additional three-year pe	eriods.

2	Section 2. The continuation of Chapter 12.D.A effected by this ordinance shall be	
3	retroactive to July 1, 2008.
