3	Ordinance designating the Monterey Cypress at 2626 Vallejo Street (Assessor's Block
4	0953, Lot 006) as a landmark tree pursuant to Public Works Code Section 810, making
5	findings supporting the designation, and requesting official acts in furtherance of the
6	landmark tree designation.

10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. Findings.
12	(a) Public Works Code Section 810 establishes a procedure for the nomination,
13	designation, and removal of landmark trees.
14	(b) On February 26, 2008, property owner Harriet Heyman nominated the Monterey
15	Cypress (Cupressus macrocarpa) located in the rear yard of her property at 2626 Vallejo
16	Street.
17	(c) The Board of Supervisors adopted landmark tree designation criteria in Resolution
18	No. 440-06. A copy of this Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in
19	File No and is incorporated herein by reference.
20	(d) On April 8, 2008, after a duly noticed public hearing, the Urban Forestry Council
21	adopted Resolution No. 005-08 recommending that the Board of Supervisors designate this
22	tree for landmark status based on the abovementioned landmark tree designation criteria. A
23	copy of said Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.
24	and is incorporated herein by reference.
25	

1	(e) The Urban Forestry Council determined that this tree qualifies as a landmark tree
2	based on the criteria set forth below and as further delineated in the City's landmark tree
3	designation criteria:
4	(1) Size: The tree is a large tree;
5	(2) Character Defining Form: The tree is a beautiful tree;
6	(3) Neighborhood Appreciation: (i) Letters recommending support of
7	landmark tree status were received; (ii) there was no stated opposition to landmark status;
8	and (iii) the tree was nominated and has the support of the property owner;
9	(4) Prominent Landscape Feature: The tree is a prominent landscape feature
10	in an area of low to moderate tree density; and
11	(5) Tree Condition: The tree is in good condition and well maintained.
12	(f) The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own the findings of the Urban Forestry
13	Council in regard to this tree.
14	Section 2. Landmark Tree Designation.
15	(a) Based on the above mentioned findings, the Board of Supervisors designates the
16	Monterey Cypress (Cupressus macrocarpa) located in the rear yard at 2626 Vallejo Street
17	(Assessor's Block 0953, Lot 006) as a landmark tree.
18	(b) The Board of Supervisors directs the Department of Public Works to record the
19	landmark designation of this tree on the property record of 2626 Vallejo Street (Assessor's
20	Block 0953, Lot 006) and list the tree in the Department's Official Book of Landmark Trees.
