10	Section 1. Findings.
11	The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this
12	Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public
13	Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
14	Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein by reference.
15	Section 2. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
16	by amending Section 249.8, to read as follows:
17	SEC. 249.8. PRIVATE AMBULANCES.
18	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in operating a private ambulance that
19	requires a permit from the Health Department shall pay an initial ambulance provider permit
20	application fee of \$10,000 at the time of filing the initial application, as well as an annual license fee
21	of $\$1,400142$ for each vehicle to the Tax Collector. The <u>annual</u> license fees prescribed by this
22	Section are due and payable on an annual basis.
