4 **Article 12, by amending Section 12.36 to increase the application fee for certification as**  
5 **a non-profit.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Findings.

11 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this  
12 Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public  
13 Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the  
14 Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_ and is incorporated herein by reference.

15 Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section  
16 12.36, to read as follows:

17 **SEC. 12.36. ATHLETIC FIELD FOR ADULTS.**

18 (a) Facility Fee Per Hour:

19 S.F. Residents . . . . \$25.00

20 Non-resident . . . . \$65.00

21 Not-for-Profit . . . . \$25.00

22 Profit . . . . \$65.00

23 (b) Additional Charges:

24 Lighted, per hour . . . . \$10.00

25 Exclusive Use/Tournaments, per day . . . . \$45.00

1 Baselines: Softball, Baseball, per booking . . . . \$60.00  
2 Fieldlines: Soccer, Football, Rugby, Lacrosse, per booking . . . . \$120.00  
3 Gaelic Football, per booking . . . . \$180.00  
4 Football (5 yards), per booking . . . . \$160.00

5 (c) Not for Profit Fees are available to organized programs that serve San Francisco  
6 residents and that do not generate income or compensation to the organizers and/or  
7 sponsors. The Commission shall establish criteria for the determination of organizations  
8 eligible for this fee. Organizations shall pay an application fee of ~~\$150.00~~ \$250.00 for  
9 certification for eligibility for Not For Profit Fees.

10 (d) For Profit Fees apply to organized programs that generate income or  
11 compensation to organizers, fundraisers or subsidies to other programs. The Commission  
12 shall establish criteria for the determination of organizations subject to this fee.
