2	administrator.]
3	Resolution authorizing enrollment in the National Flood Insurance Program, providing
4	assurances that the City, acting by and through the City Administrator, will implement
5	a floodplain management program, and authorizing the City Administrator to take
6	actions necessary to implement this resolution.
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8	WHEREAS, Certain coastal areas of the City and County of San Francisco may be
9	susceptible to periodic flooding caused by serious storm events, which could cause serious
10	damage to properties located within these areas; and
11	WHEREAS, Relief from the economic hardships of flood damage is available in the
12	form of federally subsidized flood insurance as authorized by the National Flood Insurance Ac
13	of 1968; and,
14	WHEREAS, This Board intends that potential flood hazards within these certain coasta
15	areas potentially subject to periodic flooding be recognized and evaluated in all relevant
16	official actions relating to land uses in these areas; and,
17	WHEREAS, Under Article II, sections 5 and 7 of the California Constitution, the City
18	and County of San Francisco has the legal authority to adopt land use and control measures
19	designed to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of its residents, including
20	measures to reduce future flood losses; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED, That this Board hereby approves the City's enrollment in the National
22	Flood Insurance Program administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and
23	be it
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Board assures the Federal Emergency Management
25	Agency that it will enact, as necessary, and maintain in force in those areas susceptible to

periodic flooding caused by serious storm events, adequate land use and control measures 1 2 with effective enforcement provisions consistent with the criteria set forth in Section 60.3 of 3 the National Flood Insurance Program Regulations; and, be it 4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator has the responsibility and authority 5 to: Assist the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency in the 6 7 delineation of the limits of the areas having special flood hazards, 8 Provide such information as the Administrator may request concerning present uses 9 and occupancy of the floodplain areas, 10 Cooperate with federal, state and local agencies that undertake studies, surveys, 11 mapping, and identification of floodplain areas, and cooperate with neighboring communities 12 with respect to management of adjoining floodplains, and 13 Submit on the anniversary date of the City's initial eligibility an annual report to the 14 Administrator on the progress made during the past year on the development and 15 implementation of floodplain management measures; and, be it 16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator will maintain for public inspection 17 and furnish upon request, for the purpose of determining applicable flood insurance risk 18 premium rates within all areas having special flood hazards identified on a flood hazard 19 boundary map or flood insurance rate map, any certificates for flood-proofing and information on the elevation (in relation to mean sea level) of the level of the lowest floor (including 20 21 basement) of all new or substantially improved structures, and whether or not such structures 22 contain a basement, and if the structure has been flood-proofed, the elevation (in relation to

mean sea level) to which the structure was flood-proofed; and, be it

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1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute
2	any and all documents and to take appropriate actions necessary to effectuate the City's
3	enrollment in the National Flood Insurance Program.
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
