[Grant to support a drug research study.]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$63,210 from the Public Health Foundation Enterprises (PHFE) to support the study entitled "Mirtazapine to reduce methamphetamine use among MSM with high-risk HIV behaviors project;" for the period of June 1, 2008 through May 31, 2009.

WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institutes of Health to develop and conduct a research study to utilize mirtazapine to reduce methamphetamine use among men who have sex with men (MSM) to reduce the sexual risk of HIV transmission; and,

WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse DPH \$63,210 for the period of June 1, 2008 through May 31, 2009, which extends a project first approved by the Board though File #070973; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds the PHFE requires DPH to enter into a Grant Agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 080963, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for three existing positions, including Senior Physician Specialist (Job Class #2232) at .05 FTE, Principal Administrative Analyst (Job Class #1824) at .05 FTE, and Epidemiologist II (Job Class #2803) at .20 FTE; and,

WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$8,925; now therefore, be it

1	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a gran	
2	from PHFE in the amount of \$63,210; and, be it	
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and	
4	expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,

6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the	
7	agreement on behalf of the City.	
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions	
9	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when	
10	the agreement expires.
