3	Desclution approving an amarganay public work contract under Can Eropaises		
4	Resolution approving an emergency public work contract under San Francisco		
5	Administrative Code section 6.60, to design, furnish, and install a new microwave radio		
6	system for Hetch Hetchy.		
7	WHEREAS, the City operates a fixed point-to-point microwave radio system on certain		
8	frequencies within the 2110 to 2155 MHz band, utilizing such system for the voice and data		
9	communications between Warnerville Switchyard, Moccasin Peak, Mocccasin Powerhouse		
10	repeater, Moccasin Powerhouse, Duckwall Mountain, Jones Point, and Early Intake		
11	Switchyard, essential to the operation of the City 's electric utility and water delivery system,		
12	on specified paths (the "Affected Paths"); and		
13	WHEREAS, pursuant to ET Docket No. 00-258, the Federal Communications		
14	Commission ("FCC"), reallocated and auctioned the 2110 and 2155 MHz frequencies,		
15	including those used by the City, to commercial enterprises for use by emerging technologies		
16	known as Advanced Wireless Services ("AWS"); and		
17	WHEREAS, T-MOBILE has purchased the frequencies from the FCC, has advised the		
18	City that the AWS systems may cause interference to the City 's Affected Paths and T-		
19	MOBILE has requested that the City permanently vacate its licenses to operate in the Affected		
20	Paths and relocate its operations onto other microwave frequencies available to the City or		
21	risk interference and compromised communications on the Affected Paths; and		
22	WHEREAS, on July 30, 2008, the General Manager declared an emergency, approved		
23	by the President of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, to prevent the imminent		
24	loss of dedicated City critical communication frequencies and the imminent breakdown of City		
25	plants and switchyards, to safeguard the property of the City, and to maintain the public health		

1	and safeguard the City's communications system essential to the operation of the City's		
2	electric utility and water delivery system; and		
3	WHEREAS, San Francisco Administrative Code, Chapter 6, Article IV, section 6.60,		
4	authorizes department heads responsible for public work to award an emergency contract,		
5	exempt from the competitive bidding process, in the event of an actual emergency which		
6	includes, "The breakdown or imminent breakdown of any plan, equipment, structure, street or		
7	public work necessitating immediate emergency repair or reconditioning to safeguard the lives		
8	or property of the citizens; or the property of the City and County; or to maintain the public		
9	health or welfare;" and		
10	WHEREAS, Section 6.60(D) requires that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors		
11	approve an emergency with an estimated cost in excess of \$250,000; and		
12	WHEREAS, The General Manager of the Public Utilities Commission estimates that the		
13	emergency work to provide a new microwave communication system will cost approximately		
14	\$1.2 Million; now therefore be it		
15	RESOLVED, That the General Manager of the Public Utilities Commission is		
16	authorized to award an emergency contract under San Francisco Administrative Code section		
17	6.60, and proceed with all work necessary to secure a fully functioning and operable		
18	microwave communication system for voice and data communications between Warnerville		
19	Switchyard, Moccasin Peak, Mocccasin Powerhouse repeater, Moccasin Powerhouse,		
20	Duckwall Mountain, Jones Point, and Early Intake Switchyard, with a total contract amount not		
21	to exceed \$1.2 Million; and, be it		
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller has certified that funds are available for		
23	this emergency contract; and be it
