

1 [Accept and Expend State Grant – Funding two Environmental Health programs.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**  
4 **and expend retroactively a new grant in the amount of \$8,250 from the California**  
5 **Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) funding two programs, the Petroleum**  
6 **Products Compliance program and the Weighmaster Enforcement Program; for the**  
7 **period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.**

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9 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant totaling \$8,250 from the CDFA combining  
10 awards to support two programs, the Petroleum Products Compliance program (\$6,900) and  
11 the Weighmaster Enforcement Program (\$1,350) for the period of July 1, 2008 through June  
12 30, 2009; and,

13 WHEREAS, The goal of the Petroleum Products Compliance program is to ensure  
14 minimum quality standards for most petroleum and automotive products and the goal of the  
15 Weighmaster Enforcement Program (\$1,125) is to ensure that weighing devices function  
16 properly and accurately, safeguarding consumer purchases; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDFA requires the City to  
18 comply with the terms of an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the  
19 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 081207, which is hereby declared to be a part of  
20 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

21 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required for this grant, as the funds will be  
22 used for a small portion of the following existing positions within DPH, two Inspectors of  
23 Weights and Measures (Job Class 6220), at .10 FTE; and,

24 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; and,

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1           WHEREAS, Retroactive approval is being sought because while DPH received the  
2 contract on May 30, 2008, the CDFA subsequently suspended the contract due to problems  
3 with the State's FY 2008-09 budget, and only released the suspension in early August; now,  
4 therefore, be it

5           RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant  
6 in the amount of \$8,250 from the CDFA; and, be it

7           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions  
8 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when  
9 the agreement expires; and, be it

10          FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
11 indirect costs in the budget of the Agreement; and, be it

12          FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
13 agreement on behalf of the City.
