8	WHEREAS, The Infrastructure Protection Program's, Port Security Grant Program		
9	(PSGP) provides grant funding to port areas for the protection of critical port infrastructure		
10	from terrorism, and the PSGP funds are primarily intended to assist ports in enhancing risk		
11	management capabilities, domain awareness, and prevention, detection, response and		
12	recovery from attacks involving improvised explosive devices and other non-conventional		
13	weapons; and,		
14	WHEREAS, On March 5, 2007 the Port of San Francisco, in a coordinated effort with		
15	the ports of Oakland, Richmond and Stockton, submitted an application for grant funds under		
16	the PSGP; and,		
17	WHEREAS, On August 7, 2007, the Port of San Francisco was awarded \$1,522,536 in		
18	grant funds for installation of high security fencing and regional vulnerability assessment		
19	activities; and,		
20	WHEREAS, On April 2, 2008 through Port Commission Resolution 08-18, the Port		
21	Commission authorized Port staff to accept and expend PSGP funds for security		
22	enhancements; and,		
23	WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an		
24	amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; and,

1	WHEREAS, The Port Commission proposes to maximize use of available grant fund		
2	on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore,		
3	be it		
4	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco Port		
5	Commission to accept and expend \$1,522,536 in grant funds from PSGP; and be it		
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the		
7	Executive Director of the Port or her designee to execute an agreement and any documents		
8	required for the implementation of this grant, including any amendments, augmentations or		
9	extensions thereof; and be it		
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
11	indirect costs in the grant budgets; and be it		
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Executive Director of the Port, or her designee, is		
13	hereby authorized to approve, sign and execute an agreement to hold the granting agencie		
14	harmless from liability associated with activities funded with or by this grant.
