6 WHEREAS, Jazzie Collins has been a resident of San Francisco for over twenty years;
7 and,

8 WHEREAS, Jazzie Collins has fought fiercely for transgender equality; and,

9 WHEREAS, Jazzie Collins has dedicated herself to speaking out against the injustices
10 facing transgender individuals in all spheres of her life; and,

11 WHEREAS, Jazzie Collins has been the chair of the SoMa Stabilization Fund
12 Community Advisory Committee (CAC) for two years, providing direction and leadership for
13 the CAC as well as representing the concerns of seniors and disabled residents within SoMa;
14 and,

15 WHEREAS, Jazzie Collins has worked for the Sixth Street Agenda and the Mission
16 Agenda, to better the conditions of people living in SROs, including the passage of SRO
17 visitation policies; and,

18 WHEREAS, Jazzie Collins became a resident leader for the South of Market
19 Community Action network (SOMCAN) in 2003 and joined the staff at SOMCAN as a resident
20 advocate in 2005; therefore be it

21 RESOLVED, That we honor Jazzie Collins for her inspirational leadership and
22 invaluable contributions to improve the lives of SoMa residents and advance the sustainability
23 of San Francisco’s cultural and economic diversity.
