17	WHEREAS, Leaders in health,	labor, business, governance, community, physicians
18	and staff at St. Luke's, through the Bl	ue Ribbon Panel ("BRP") process, recommend that the
19	California Pacific Medical Center ("CF	PMC"), the largest private health system in San
20	Francisco, continue to support St. Luke's mission, rebuild St. Luke's, and integrate this	
21	campus into CPMC's health care syst	em; and,

resolution 148-08 adopted April 1, 2008, to maintain acute services at St. Luke's Hospital;
