| 5 | WHEREAS, The Office of the Public Defender submitted two requisitions that were |
| 6 | rejected by the Mayor's Office requesting approval for two new employees (entry level 8173) |
| 7 | to replace two vacancies created by the resignation of one legal assistant and the ADA |
| 8 | replacement of another legal assistant; and, |
| 9 | WHEREAS, The department has sufficient monies in its current budget to hire two |
| 10 | legal assistants under 8173; and, |
| 11 | WHEREAS, Leaving the positions unfilled will result in attorneys prioritizing which |
| 12 | critical aspects of trial and case preparation can be "completed later" and which are most |
| 13 | urgent for the paralegal, whose workload has increased 35%, to complete; and, |
| 14 | WHEREAS, Without adequate resources, the attorney will be performing paralegal |
| 15 | duties at a much higher salary; and, |
| 16 | WHEREAS, Without adequate paralegal support, cases are delayed, incarceration |
| 17 | periods and case dispositions are increased, all resulting in increased costs due to the |
| 18 | delays; and, |
| 19 | WHEREAS, The Board may grant approval of the requisition as per Section 1.1D of |
| 20 | the 2008/09 Annual Salary Ordinance; and, now, therefore be it |
| 21 | RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors approves Requisitions #P8023/1103021 and |
| 22 | P8024/1103124 allowing the Office of the Public Defender to fill its empty staff positions. |
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
