WHEREAS, The California Corrections Standards Authority (CSA) administers the Juvenile Probation and Camp Funding (JPCF) Program, which provides funds to support a broad spectrum of county probation services targeting at-risk youth, juvenile offenders, and the families of these youth; and

WHEREAS, The Department desires to participate in the JPCF Program and use the grant funds to benefit children in San Francisco by providing eligible services to promote increased self-sufficiency, personal responsibility, and family stability for the child; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the Chief Probation Officer for the Juvenile Probation Department, or a designee, to execute for and on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the JPCF Program Agreement with the CSA, including any extensions or amendments to that Agreement, and to

execute any other agreements, applications, assurances, certificates and other documents and to take any additional actions necessary to obtain JPCF Program funding for Fiscal Year 2008-2009; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco agrees to abide by the statutes governing the JPCF Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Agreement as set forth by the CSA, including the retention of financial records substantiating claimed expenditures and the submission of Semi-Annual Progress Reports.
