4	Resolution No, concerning findings pursuant to the California Environmental					
5	Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). A copy of said					
6	Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No and i	is				
7	incorporated by reference herein.					
8	Section 2. The San Francisco Planning Code is hereby amended by adding Section					
9	327.6(i), to read as follows:					
10	<u>SEC. 327.6(i).</u>					
11	(i) Upon receipt of Within 60 days of receiving the Eastern Neighborhoods Capital					
12	Expenditure Evaluation Report as specified in Administrative Code Section 10E.7, the Board	d				
13	of Supervisors Office of the Controller shall assess whether funds collected from the Eastern	<u>n</u>				
14	Neighborhoods Impact Fee are being effectively utilized for capital projects serving the					
15	Eastern Neighborhoods, and whether such projects are successfully advancing towards					
16	implementation, as set forth in the abovementioned Section. Based on this assessment, the	<u> </u>				
17	following shall occur:					
18	(A) Should the Board of Supervisors determine that these fees are being If the					
19	Controller determines that the funds have been effectively utilized as set forth in Section					
20	10E.7 of the Administrative Code, the BoardController, by motion and within 120 days of					
21	receiving the Capital Expenditure Evaluation, shall make shall issue an affirmative finding to	<u>)</u>				
22	the Board of Supervisors and the Planning Commission certifying that the intention of this					
23	aforementioned Section is being met. No further Board of Supervisor Controller action is					
24	necessary for purposes of this Subsection.

1	(B) Should the Board of Supervisors determine that the fees are not being effectively
2	utilized, or fail to make the motion referred to in Subsection (A) above, within 120 days of
3	receiving the Capital Expenditure Evaluation, then the following projects shall require a
4	conditional use authorization, If the Controller fails to issue the certification described in
5	Subsection (i)(A) above or if the Controller determines that the fees are not being effectively
6	utilized as set forth in Administrative Code Section 10E.7 and notifies the Board of
7	Supervisors and Planning Commission of this determination, then the following shall occur:
8	(i) Any project specified below within the Eastern Neighborhoods Area
9	Plan that has not already received final and effective approvals from the Planning
10	Department, Zoning Administrator, and/or the Planning Commission, shall require a
11	conditional use authorization, in addition to any other approvals necessary under the Planning
12	<u>Code:</u>
13	(aa) Residential projects containing more than 10 new units that have not
14	received issuance of their first site or building permit; or
15	(bb) Non-residential projects containing a net new addition or new
16	construction of 10,000 square feet or more that have not received issuance of their first site or
17	building permit.
18	(C) Elimination of interim conditional use requirement. (i) At any time
19	after the Controller has determined that Eastern Neighborhood impact fees are not being
20	effectively utilized as set forth in Section 327.6(i)(B) above, or fails to certify that they are
21	being effectively utilized as set forth in Section 327.6(i)(A), the Planning Department may
22	provide the Controller with a newly updated or revised Eastern Neighborhoods Capital
23	Expenditure Evaluation Report.

1	(ii) Within 60 days of receiving an updated or revised Report, the Office of the					
2	Controller shall determine whether funds collected from the Eastern Neighborhoods Public					
3	Benefit Fee are being effectively utilized for capital projects serving the Eastern					
4	Neighborhoods consistent with the intent of the Section 10E.7 of the Administrative Code.					
5	(iii) If, on the basis of a new, updated or revised Eastern Neighborhoods Capital					
6	Expenditure Evaluation Report, the Controller determines that the development impact fees					
7	collected to date are being effectively utilized as set forth in Section 327.6(i)(A) above, any					
8	projects within the Eastern Neighborhoods Plan Area that required a conditional use					
9	authorization on an interim basis as set forth in Section 327.6(i)(B) shall no longer require					
10	such conditional use authorization unless the underlying use requires conditional use					
11	authorization independent of the requirements set forth in Section 327.6(i)(B).
