1 [Appointment – Immigrant Rights Commission]

Motion appointing Ana Perez, term ending June 6, 2009, to the Immigrant Rights Commission, residency requirement waived.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as member of the Immigrant Rights Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 211-97, for the term specified:

Ana Perez (residency requirement waived), succeeding Falguni Sheth, seat 10, resigned, must be an immigrant to the United States who is appointed in accordance with Section 4.101 of the Charter. In addition, member shall have demonstrated knowledge of and interest in the health, human service, educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for an unexpired portion of a two-year term ending June 6, 2009; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Immigrant Rights Commission has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Ana Perez, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a
 person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Immigrant Rights
 Commission.
- 3. The Immigrant Rights Commission has attempted to fill the position, for which Ana Perez was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Ana Perez is qualified to serve on the Immigrant Rights Commission.

1	4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
2	other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the
3	specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is
4	willing to serve on the Immigrant Rights Commission at this time; and, be it
5	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
6	for Ana Perez, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be
7	found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to
8	boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of
9	Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
