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Motion disapproving the determination by the Planning Department that the 717 Battery Street/350 Pacific Avenue project is categorically exempt from environmental review 6nder the California Environmental Quality Act.

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- 8 WHEREAS, On or around January 16, 2009, the Environmental Review Office of the San Francisco Planning department issued a certificate of determination of 19 memption/exclusion from environmental review (the "determination") for a proposal to add to 19 members and rehabilitate the Musto Building at 717 Battery Street/350 Pacific Avenue, to expand the 19 members and provide ground-floor commercial and restaurant space (the "Project"). 12 members and document is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 19 members and is incorporated by reference herein; and,

- 21 WHEREAS, This Board has reviewed and considered the determination, the appeal 21/2 tter, the responses to concerns document that the Planning Department prepared, and 25/2 testimony; and,
- WHEREAS, The determination files and all correspondence and other documents have 25een made available for review by this Board and the public. These files are available for

public review by appointment at the Planning Department offices at 1660 Mission Street, and are part of the record before this Board by reference herein; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That this Board of Supervisors disapproves the determination by the Planning Department that the Project is exempt/excluded from environmental review.
