## Resolution calling for a municipal special election to be held no later than August 31, 2009, for the purpose of submitting revenue and fiscal measures to the voters.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors wishes to submit revenue and fiscal measures to the voters prior to the next regularly scheduled election; and

WHEREAS, Charter section 13.103 states that special elections may be called in accordance with state laws; and

WHEREAS, California Elections Code section 10201 provides that a special election may be called for the purpose of voting on a proposition; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is contemplating calling a municipal special election to be held no later than August 31, 2009, for the purpose of submitting revenue and fiscal measures to the voters; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That a special election is called and ordered to be held in the City on

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this special election shall be held according to the laws of the State of California, the Charter and Municipal Elections Code of the City; and any regulations adopted under State law, the Charter, or the Municipal Elections Code providing for and governing elections in the City.
