(CEQA), 14 California Code of Regulations Sections 15000 et seq. (the "CEQA Guidelines") and Chapter 31 of the 24 San Francisco Administrative Code ("Chapter 31"); the Planning Department found the 25

13	WHEREAS, On July 8, 2008, at a public meeting of the SFPUC, the SFPUC adopted
14	Resolution No. 08- 0120, in which the SFPUC: (1) adopted CEQA Findings and the Final
15	IS/MND and, adopted the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP), which
16	SFPUC Resolution and Attachments are incorporated herein as part of this Resolution by this
17	reference thereto, and (2) approved the Project and authorized staff to proceed with actions
18	necessary to implement the Project. SFPUC Resolution No. 08-0120, which is on file with the
19	Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No, including its findings, is incorporated
