11	WHEREAS, The Act identified projects to be reviewed by the U.S. Department of	
12	Justice (USDOJ) Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for	
13	consistency with law and Congressional intent; and	
14	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco was awarded a grant in the amoun	
15	of \$1,475,675 for the Forensic Sciences Center project which aims to consolidate and re-	
16	locate the Office of Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) and the San Francisco Police	
17	Department Forensic Services Division (SFPD FSD); and	
18	WHEREAS, The SFPD FSD and OCME relocation project was included in the 10 year	
19	capital plan approved by the Board of Supervisors on April 15, 2008, File No. 080333; and	
20	WHEREAS, The Edward Byrne Memorial Discretionary Grant will provide funds for the	
21	planning and design of the new Forensic Sciences Center; and	
22	WHEREAS, The grant award period began on August 1, 2008 and expenditures after	
23	this date are eligible for reimbursement; and	
24	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

1	WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit the inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget		
2	now, therefore be it		
3	RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Public Works of		
4	his or her designee to retroactively accept and expend these grant funds and any continued		
5	funding for this project from the USDOJ, BJA; and be it		
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Public Works is authorized to execute		
7	on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Agreement for this		
8	project including any extensions, funding augmentations from the USDOJ/BJA, or		
9	amendments thereof; and be it		
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of performance of		
11	this Grant Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of		
12	the authorizing agency; and be it
