

[Approval of Sheriff's Contract for Jail Commissary and Inmate Trust Fund Accounting & Management System with ARAMARK Correctional Services, LLC.]

**Resolution approving a contract for operating the Sheriff's Jail Commissary and Inmate Trust Fund Accounting & Management System, Between ARAMARK Correctional Services, LLC. (ARAMARK), and the City and County of San Francisco, Acting by and through its Sheriff's Department.**

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Sheriff's Department requested bids for the Jail Commissary and Inmate Trust Fund Accounting Management System; and,

WHEREAS, A three-member panel evaluated and scored the written proposals in accordance with the City-approved selection criteria; and,

WHEREAS, The Human Rights Commission determined DBE/LBE subcontracting goals do not apply; and,

WHEREAS, The three-member panel determined ARAMARK Correctional Services, LLC. is the best responsive and responsible proposer; and,

WHEREAS, Charter Section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations", Subsection (a) requires Board of Supervisors' approval of any contract which, when entered into, has anticipated revenue of one million dollars or more; and,

WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has an Inmate Welfare Fund, as provided for in California Penal Code Section 5000-5030.1; and,

WHEREAS, ARAMARK Correctional Services, LLC. shall pay to the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund a percentage commission of 42.5% of net sales, with a guaranteed annual minimum income of \$650,000; and,

1           WHEREAS, The proposed contract agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board  
2 of Supervisors in File No. 090450, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution  
3 as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

4           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Jail Commissary  
5 and Inmate Trust Fund Accounting & Management System Agreement by and between  
6 ARAMARK Correctional Services, LLC., and the City and County of San Francisco, acting  
7 by and through its Sheriff's Department, for a three-year term, and two one-year options  
8 exercisable by the Sheriff's Department.
