3	Inmate Trust Fund Accounting & Management System, Between ARAMARK
4	Correctional Services, LLC. (ARAMARK), and the City and County of San Francisco,

7	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Sheriff's Department requested bids for the Jail
8	Commissary and Inmate Trust Fund Accounting Management System; and,
9	WHEREAS, A three-member panel evaluated and scored the written proposals in
10	accordance with the City-approved selection criteria; and,
11	WHEREAS, The Human Rights Commission determined DBE/LBE subcontracting
12	goals do not apply; and,
13	WHEREAS, The three-member panel determined ARAMARK Correctional
14	Services, LLC. is the best responsive and responsible proposer; and,
15	WHEREAS, Charter Section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations", Subsection
16	(a) requires Board of Supervisors' approval of any contract which, when entered into, has
17	anticipated revenue of one million dollars or more; and,
18	WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has an Inmate Welfare Fund, as provided for
19	in California Penal Code Section 5000-5030.1; and,
20	WHEREAS, ARAMARK Correctional Services, LLC. shall pay to the Sheriff's
21	Inmate Welfare Fund a percentage commission of 42.5% of net sales, with a guaranteed
22	annual minimum income of \$650,000; and,

6	ARAMARK Correctional Services, LLC., and the City and County of San Francisco, acting
7	by and through its Sheriff's Department, for a three-year term, and two one-year options
8	exercisable by the Sheriff's Department.
