[Accept and expend grant – Expanding services for mentally ill parolees.]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept and expend retroactively a grant from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) in the amount of \$1,925,719 to expand the City's treatment capacity for mentally ill parolees; for the period of June 1, 2009 through June 30, 2012,

WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from CDCR in the amount of \$1,925,719 for a project entitled Integrated Services for Mentally III Parolee-Clients; for the period of June 1, 2009 through June 30, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of this grant is to expand the City's treatment capacity for mentally ill parolees through various services including intensive case management, skills training, advocacy and recovery support; and,

WHEREAS, DPH will subcontract with Walden House, a community-based organization with a 39-year history of providing comprehensive services to parolees and probationers, in the amount of \$1,587,570 for the period of the grant; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDCR requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 090638; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses DPH for two existing positions, including Epidemiologist II (Job Class #2803), and Health Worker II (Job Class #2586) both at .50 FTE; the Project Director's time at .10 FTE will be provided inkind; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$31,569; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$1,925,719 from CDCR; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the agreement expires.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
