3	Ordinance amending Section 128.1 of the San Francisco Health Code to increase fees
4	for Fire Department emergency medical services and to update the language regarding
5	fee changes in subsequent fiscal years, and making environmental findings.

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9	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
10	Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
11	this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California
12	Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of
13	the Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein by reference.
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15	Section 2. The San Francisco Health Code is hereby amended by amending Section
16	128.1, to read as follows:
17	Sec. 128.1 PATIENT RATES/FIRE DEPARTMENT EMS SERVICES
18	(a) The Board of Supervisors approves the following fee schedule for Fire Department
19	emergency medical services, for fiscal year 2008-20092009-2010:
20	(1) Treatment without Transportation, a base rate fee of <u>\$260.00</u> \$350.00 per call.
21	(2) Basic Life Service, including transportation, a base rate fee of \$1,053.00\$1,458 per
22	call.
23	(3) Advanced Life Service, including transportation, a base rate fee of \$1,053.00\$1,458
24	per call.
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<u>(4)</u> Mileage if transported, an additional fee above the base rate of \$18.00\$28.00 per
mile.

3 (b) Beginning with Fiscal Year 2009 2010 2010 - 2011, the fees set in this section may be 4 amended without further action by the Board of Supervisors, to reflect changes in the Medical 5 Consumer Price Index as determined by the Controller. No later than April 15th of each year, the Fire Department shall submit its current fee schedule to the Controller, who shall apply the 6 7 price index adjustment to produce a new fee schedule for the following year. 8 (c) No later than May 15th of each year, the Controller shall file a report with the Board 9 of Supervisors reporting the new fee schedule and certifying that: (a) the fees produce sufficient revenue to support the costs of providing the services for which each fee is 10 11 assessed, and (b) the fees do not produce revenue which is significantly more than the costs 12 of providing the services for which each fee is assessed. 13 14 Section 3.
