- 10 Section 1. Findings.
- 11 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this
 12 Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public
 13 Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
- Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section 16 12.05, to read as follows:

SEC. 12.05. JAPANESE TEA GARDEN

The following fees shall be charged for admission to the Japanese Tea Garden:

Age/ Category	Admission Fee S.F.Residents	Non-Residents
Adult	\$5.00	<u>\$7.00</u>
Senior (65+)	\$3.00	<u>\$5.00</u>
Youth (1217 years)	\$3.00	<u>\$5.00</u>
Child (511 years)	\$1.50	<u>\$2.00</u>
Child (4 years and under)	\$0.00	<u>\$0.00</u>

(b) Audio Tours: Upon development, and approval by the Commission, of an audio 1 2 tour for the facility, the entrance fee for the facility shall be increased by \$1.00 to cover the 3 cost of rental of the tour. (c) Recreation and Park Commission is authorized to designate three free hours per 4 5 week for entry to the Japanese Tea Garden. The Recreation and Park Commission is authorized to establish programs offering: 6 Bulk purchase admission tickets for groups of over 20 people at a discount of no 7 8 more than 50 cents from the standard individual admission fee; 9 (2) Special time-limited promotions to change admission fees (including, but not limited to, joint marketing promotions, coupons, free hours or days). Promotional discounts will 10 11 be limited to the equivalent of 20,000 full price admissions annually. The Department will report within 90 days of the end of any promotion, or annually 12 13 for ongoing promotions, to the Recreation and Park Commission of the efficacy of any 14 promotion in increasing visitation and the impact on revenues to the Department.
