1	[Proposition J Contract/Certification of Specified Contracted-Out Services under City Administrator/ Fiscal Emergency]		
2	Administrator, Floodi Emergeney		
3	Resolution concurring with the Controller's certification that services can be performed		
4	by private contractor for a lower cost than similar work performed by City and County		
5	employees for citywide janitorial services under the City Administrator, and concurring		
6	in determination of fiscal emergency.		
7	WHEREAS, The State's projected budget deficit for 2009-2010 is approximately \$24		
8	billion dollars which will result in significant revenue reductions to the City and County budget;		
9	and,		
10	WHEREAS, The State of California and local jurisdictions are enacting emergency cost		
11	saving measures throughout California in an attempt to address these projected budget		
12	deficits; and,		
13	WHEREAS, The continuing weak economy, delayed recovery, and drop in government		
14	revenues in California and in San Francisco have dramatically and adversely impacted the		
15	City's fiscal condition over the past several years, creating a fiscal emergency for the City and		
16	County of San Francisco; and		
17	WHEREAS, For example, the City and County of San Francisco faces significant		
18	increases in its costs in fiscal year 2009-2010, including an increase in \$61 million in fund		
19	contributions to the Employee Retirement System, and an increase in approximately \$13		
20	million in health and dental benefits for both current and retired employees mandated by		
21	Charter and labor agreements; and		
22	WHEREAS, The City is facing signficant additional cuts in funding from the State due		
23	to the State's fiscal crisis; and,		
24	WHEREAS, To balance its budget the City must use all of the amounts available under		
25	the City's Rainy Day Reserve; and,		

1	WHEREAS, The Mayor has determined that the state of the City's budget for fiscal						
2	year 2009-2010 as indicated herein has created an emergency situation justifying the						
3	contracting out of certain City services that can be performed for a lower cost by private						
4	companies than by City and County employees; and,						
5	WHEREAS, The Electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed						
6	Proposition J in November 1976, allowing City and County Departments to contract with						
7	private companies for specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar						
8	work by City and County employees (Charter Section 10.104.15); and,						
9	WHEREAS, The Controller has determined that the award of a contract for the services						
10	listed below to a private contractor will achieve substantial cost savings for the City; and,						
11	WHEREAS, The Controller's certification, which confirms that said services can be						
12	performed at lower costs to the City and County by private contractor than by employees of						
13	the City and County, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File						
14	No, which is hereby declared to be part of this resolution as if set forth						
15	fully herein; now, therefore be it;						
16	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's						
17	certification, and the Mayor's determination of an emergency situation, and approves the						
18	Proposition J Resolution concerning the award of a contract to a private contractor for the						
19	services listed below for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
