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7	WHEREAS, In December 2009, the Port applied to the California Department of Fish		
8	and Game, Oil Spill Response and Recovery division (OSPR) for funding to purchase oil spill		
9	response equipment, including 1,000 feet of oil containment boom and a mobile trailer for		
10	quick deployment of that equipment; and,		
11	WHEREAS, On March 30, 2009, OSPR awarded the Port a grant in the amount of		
12	\$25,000 for that purpose; and,		
13	WHEREAS, OSPR conducted a competitive bid process and selected a vendor from		
14	whom grant awardees are required to purchase response equipment with granted funds; and		
15	WHEREAS, The Port will seek a sole-source waiver or other exemption from the		
16	Purchaser's Office in order to purchase the equipment from the OSPR-selected vendor; and,		
17	WHEREAS, On May 12, 2009, through Port Commission Resolution 09-24, the San		
18	Francisco Port Commission authorized Port staff to accept and expend the \$25,000 awarded		
19	by OSPR; and,		
20	WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an		
21	amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; and,		
22	WHEREAS, All grant funding will go toward purchase of oil spill response equipment,		
23	with no monies to be applied to indirect costs; now, therefore, be it		
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1	RESOLVED, That the	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the San Francisco Port		
2	Commission to accept and expend \$25,000 in grant funding from OSPR for purchase of oil			
3	spill response equipment; and be it

5	indirect costs as a part of this grant; and be it			
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the
