The General Manager is hereby authorized to enter into any amendments or modifications to the Settlement Agreement and Declaration and Agreement Regarding Encroachments and to consent to any matters with respect to the Settlement Agreement and Declaration and Agreement Regarding Encroachments that the General Manager determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interest of the City and the SFPUC, do not materially increase City's obligations or liabilities, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Settlement Agreement and Declaration and Agreement Regarding Encroachments, and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including City's Charter.
