9	participate in a program designated "Oil Spill Response Equipment Grant Program; and		
10	WHEREAS, this grant will enable the SFPD Marine Unit to purchase oil spill response		
11	equipment, providing the ability to react and protect city waterfront areas from oil spill		
12	damage; and,		
13	WHEREAS, the Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco is authorized		
14	on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to apply for retroactively, accept and		
15	expend continued funding for this program from the California Department of Fish and Game

17	WHEREAS, the grant does not require an ASO amendment; and		
18	WHEREAS, the grant terms prohibit including direct costs in the grant budget; now,		
19	therefore, be it		
20	RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco is		
21	authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Gran		
22	Award Agreement for this program including any extensions, amendments, funding		
23	augmentations from the California Department of Fish and Game; and, be it		
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
25	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it		

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Police Department at its own		
2	expense, agrees to replace any grant funded purchases if it is destroyed or rendered useless		
3	prior to the expiration of this grant award agreement; and be it		
4	FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance		
5	of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the		
6	responsibility of the City and the San Francisco Police Department; and be it		
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to		
8	supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
