10	Assistant Editor and Editor of Local 790's award-winning publication United Worker; and
11	WHEREAS, He brought varied skills and experiences to his union work, including his
12	degree in Journalism from Bonaventure University, his organizing as an anti-Vietnam War
13	activist, his time as a film critic and columnist, his media savvy as a long-member of Media
14	Alliance's Board of Directors, and his editing and administrative skills honed as Coordinator of
15	the East Bay Voice; and
16	WHEREAS, He continued to use his research, organizing and communications skills in
17	SEIU 1021, spending a couple of months in New Mexico in the union's 2008 Obama
18	campaign and helping the San Francisco chapter through a recent difficult contract campaign;

20	WHEREAS, He will undoubtedly continue to contribute his accumulated skills and
21	wisdom to further the cause of workers everywhere; now, therefore, be it
22	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors recognize and honor Tim
