Resolution approving an emergency public work contract under San Francisco

Administrative Code Section 6.60 to replace sewers on Lexington Street from 20th to 4 21st Street and on San Carlos Street from 18th Street to Sycamore Street. 5

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WHEREAS, On May 6, 2009, visual observation by San Francisco Public Utilities Commission personnel noted a 4' x 6' depression on Lexington Street between 20th Street and 21st Street, and subsequent CCTV inspection of the sewer in that area revealed multiple side sewer connections separated from the main sewer, multiple severe open connections in the main sewer, and rodent infestation;

WHEREAS, On May 6, 2009, inspection of a cave-in on a portion of San Carlos Street from 18th Street to Sycamore Street by San Francisco Public Utilities Commission personnel revealed 80 feet of collapsed main sewer with a compromised catch basin and culvert. Subsequent inspection noted severe cracks in portions of the main sewer that had not collapsed;

WHEREAS, To protect the public's health and safety, the damaged and collapsed sewer needs to be replaced and immediately returned to service; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Administrative Code, Chapter 6, Article IV, section 6.60, authorizes department heads responsible for public work to award an emergency contract, exempt from the competitive bidding process, in the event of an actual emergency which includes, "... The breakdown or imminent breakdown of any plant, equipment, structure, street or public work necessitating immediate emergency repair or reconditioning to safeguard the lives or property of the citizens; or the property of the City and County; or to maintain the public health or welfare;" and

1	WHEREAS, On May 6, 2009, the General Manager declared an emergency, approved
2	by the President of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, to replace the sewers on
3	Lexington Street from 20 th Street to 21 st Street and on San Carlos Street from 18 th Street to
4	Sycamore Street and thereby protect public health and safety; and
5	WHEREAS, Section 6.60(D) requires that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors
6	approve an emergency with an estimated cost in excess of \$250,000; and
7	WHEREAS, The General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission
8	estimates that the emergency work to replace the sewers on Lexington Street from 20 th Street
9	to 21st Street and on San Carlos Street from 18th Street to Sycamore Street will cost
10	approximately \$356,751; now therefore be it
11	RESOLVED, That the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities
12	Commission is authorized to award an emergency contract under San Francisco
13	Administrative Code section 6.60, and proceed with all work necessary to replace the main
14	sewers on Lexington Street from 20 th Street to 21 st Street and on San Carlos Street from 18 th
15	Street to Sycamore Street, with a total contract amount not to exceed \$356,751; and, be it
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller has certified that funds are available for
17	this emergency contract; and be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That any action to date by the San Francisco Public Utilities
19	Commission to secure such emergency contract and resolve the emergency condition is
20	hereby ratified.
