9	CDFA, including Petroleum and Weighmaster project (\$8,250), Egg Inspections (\$2,465.40),		
10	and Organic Foods (\$1,140) for a total of \$11,855.40 for the period of July 1, 2009 through		
11	June 30, 2010; and		
12	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDFA requires the City to		
13	comply with the terms of three separate agreements (the "Agreements"), copies of which are		
14	on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>091042</u> , which is hereby		
15	declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
16	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses		
17	the Department for three existing positions: two Agricultural Inspectors (Job Class #3450) at		
18	0.05 and 0.06 FTE and an Inspector of Weights and Measures (Job Class #6220) 0.05 FTE		
19	for the period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and,		
20	WHEREAS, The budget does not include a provision for indirect costs because CDFA		
21	does not allow it; now therefore, be it		
22	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively three		
23	grant from the in the amount of \$11,855.40; and, be it		
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
25	indirect costs in the grant budgets; and be it
