12	WHEREAS, Through this grant, PHFE has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of		
13	\$15,055 for the period of April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010; and,		
14	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, PHFE requires the City to		
15	enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the		
16	Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>091043</u> ; which is hereby declared to be a part of		
17	this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
18	WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH		
19	for one existing position, Epidemiologist II (Job Class #2803) at .10 FTE, for the period of Apr		
20	1, 2009 through March 31, 2010; and,		
21	WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not		
22	receive the agreement from PHFE until July 24, 2009; and,		
23	WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$2,518; now
