Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type-42 on-sale beer and wine public premises liquor license to Decant SF, LLC, doing business as Decant SF, located at 1168 Folsom Street (District 6), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4; correcting a resolved clause in File No. 190135; and requesting that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.

WHEREAS, Decant SF, LLC is seeking the issuance of a Type-42 on-sale beer and wine public premises liquor license to do business as Decant SF, located at 1168 Folsom Street (District 6); and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero protests and zero letters of support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. daily; 2) petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on the most-recently-certified ABC-253; and 3) no noise shall be audible at any nearby residence; and

WHEREAS, The Public Safety and Neighborhood Services Committee held a public hearing on March 7, 2019, and directed the preparation of a resolution finding that the public convenience or necessity would be served by the issuance of the license; and

WHEREAS, The resolution drafted in Board of Supervisors File No. 190135 mistakenly misidentified the applicant, service premise, and liquor license type which is under consideration by the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines that the issuance of a Type-42 on-sale beer and wine public premises liquor license to Decant SF, LLC, doing business as Decant SF, located at 1168 Folsom Street (District 6), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it
